Racing numbers are reserved on a ***FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED*** basis. Karters wishing to reserve their numbers for this coming year are welcome to start mailing in their kart number registration forms at any time.

The \$5.00 fee per kart number registered will save you any disappointment and additional costs in replacing numbers on race day. Moving forward for 2010, all numbers must be clearly marked on all 4 sides of the kart. Numbers altered in any way or with tape will NOT be acceptable.
