I happy to be able to inform you that on Saturday, April 3rd, 2010, I am organizing a karting event at the Formula Kartways facility in Brampton, Ontario, that will unite three levels of Ontario karting and also benefit the Crohns and Colitis Foundation of Canada.

The prime goal of the event is to unite Ontario karting in one place with the purpose of having fun. The main attraction will be a karting event pitting Canadian Rookie Karting Championship members against Indoor karters and Club level karters. This head-to-head-to-head challenge event will feature elimination-style racing where 120 competitors are whittled down to just 9 racing for a \$1000 Champions purse!

I also believe this is an ideal time to arrange an Ontario Kart Expo. I believe every kart dealer, track, and club can benefit by being represented during such an event, which in turns benefits karting as a whole in Ontario. With such a unique format, interest is sure to be high, much higher even than the 120 registered entrants. Such an event is an excellent opportunity for your club or business to market itself to a vast array of karting enthusiasts assembled under one roof.

Participating in the Kart Expo is quite simple: the fee is the donation of 1 non-karting related prize with a value above \$75, and 1 karting-related prize with a value of above \$25. There is also an optional opportunity to donate to the Crohns and Colitis Foundation of Canada (CCFC), an opportunity that will also be presented to participating drivers and those attending the event.
