



The Waterloo Regional Kart Club would like to update everyone on our State of the Art Karting Facility being built at Flamboro Speedway. Late October construction began, digging out the layout of the new track. Approximately 700 feet of drainage was installed including 6 area drains, 1400 tones of gravel was laid for the track base and the first layer of asphalt was put down. Our club held 2 work days at the Flamboro Track, installing computer wires, scoring loops, placing the container, banding tire barriers and landscaping, among other things.

We had 300 feet of concrete edging and the final coat of asphalt ready to go, but the early Canadian Winter got ahead of us, causing delays to our final construction.

At this point we have reached 50% of our goal of 100 contributors buying a section of asphalt of this new track. All of us at the WRKC would like to thank all of our current and past member's as well as local businesses and friends of the WRKC for contributing to make this outstanding project happen.

WRKC is working closely with Paul Cook at ASN Canada as well as all the necessary contractors to be sure we are ready to race in the Spring of 2008. Our club still has a lot of work to be done, including several work days in the spring as well as finding some more contributors to raise the funds that are needed to complete this project. The karting community across Canada has already given our club 100% support to see this project through.
