**Waterloo Regional Kart Club

The Waterloo Regional Kart Club started the 2011 season with a record number of racers for a club race at Flamboro Speedway. The clubs racers put on a great show with some great racing action all day long. The club had to split both the Cadet and Novice classes, and the outlook for both the Sr. Heavy and Sr. lite classes is very encouraging.

In the Cadet A class it was Caleb Colling taking the first feature win of the year, Jake Watson posted the fastest race lap but had to settle for 2nd place. Tyson Wassink had a strong run to finish in 3rd place, with Jacob Lacey and Josh Bisschop rounding out the top 5. In Cadet B it was Mia Whitney with the win, Carson Nagy in 2nd place, Kyle DaSilva in 3rd, Victoria Adams in 4th, and Sarah Hall in 5th.

The Novice A class win was claimed by Andrew Whelan, Hudson Turpin was 2nd, Ciarra Collison was close behind in 3rd, Skyler Bailey was 4th and Aaron Turnbull claimed the 5th place podium spot. In Novice B it was Madison Colling with the win, Peter Ditner finished in 2nd, Liam Shea was 3rd Joshua Bowler was 4th and Travis Moberg claimed the 5th place trophy.

The Jr. Lite race saw Austin Bisschop win from the pole position posting the fastest race lap in the process. Jordan Howse was 2nd, Clay Vaneerd was 3rd, Kaitlin Neely was 4th and Tyler Paquette was 5th. The Jr. Heavy class staged one of the closest battles of the day with Darren Dryden finishing in first less than half a second ahead of Ryan Fraser. Fraser had his hands full with Joshua Shantz keeping the pressure on to finish in 3rd place. Jared Gill had the fastest race lap and converted that into a 4th place finish, Craig Willis claimed the 5th place on the podium.

In the Senior Classes it was Adam Racine with the win in Sr. Lite, Tristan Gill was 2nd, Ryan Brutzki 3rd, James Moore 4th, and Eric Rier finishing in the 5th place spot. Sr. Heavy was won by TJ Marshall, Adrian Stahle was 2nd, David Miller, 3rd, Tyler Hendricks in 4th, and James Tait in 5th. The Masters class saw veteran racer Gerry Reis get the victory, John Dryden was 2nd, Michael Grinyer was 3rd, Rich Mizener 4th, and Dan Bailey was 5th.
