RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT.

In consideration of being granted the benefits and privilege of Membership by the Waterloo Regional Kart Club; I the undersigned, for myself, my personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, **Do**:

- a. Hereby agree to assume all responsibility and liability for all acts or activities of myself, my drivers, assistants and crew for any and all damage or injury that may be caused by any or all of us by our kart, motor, properties or possessions in any way growing our of or resulting from the operation of our equipment and/or as a result of our participating in a WRKC event or practice during the actual sanctioned and licensed period.
- b. Hereby agree to be bound by the rules of the Waterloo Regional Kart Club that decisions of its officials and/or interpretation of the applicable competition rules will be governed exclusively by the administrative review and appeal procedure in these WRKC's Rules and Regulations.
- c. Hereby release, waiver discharge and covenant not to sue the WRKC, including all its corporate, elected and appointed officials, all members of committees referees and inspectors, its individual members, **any race track hired for the use of WRKC**, KW Oktoberfest Inc., agencies of government which control essential land sites, financiers and firms which render essential service gratis, including all officers, agents and employees of the foregoing and volunteer workers assisting in Waterloo Regional Kart Club race, practice, training event or social event, all hereinafter referred to a "Releases" from or for any and all liability to me, my personal representatives heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns for all loss of damage for bodily injury, death or damage to property of the undersigned which in any way grows out of our results from any WRKC race or practice activity or part thereof, during the actual period and whether any such claim may be based upon alleged active or passive negligence whether caused by he release or otherwise, or participation in the wrong, or upon any alleged breach of any statuary duty or obligation and
- d. Hereby agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless the releases and each of them from any loss liability damage or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in our upon the restricted area or in any way competing officiating, observing or working of r, any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by negligence of the releases or otherwise
- e. Hereby assume full responsibility of and risk of bodily injury, death or property damage due to the negligence of releases or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while completing, officiating observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in any event, organized by the Waterloo Regional Kart Club.

The undersigned expressly acknowledges and agrees that the kart racing is very dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death an/or property damage, the undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver and indemnity agreement is intended to be a broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the Province in which any event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
- g. Hereby agree that the WRKC or its assigns, on a non-exclusive; basis may use my name and pictures including pictures of my racing equipment, taken at any event for publicity purposes.

Zero Tolerance Policy for Physical and Verbal Abuse Waterloo Regional Kart Club

The mission of the Waterloo Regional Kart Club is to provide a safe, fare, positive and respectful environment where all drivers, families, officials and spectators can enjoy the sport of racing.

The racetrack must be free of negative factors, such as abuse, discrimination, intimidation, hateful words and deeds, and physical violence in any form.

The Waterloo Regional Kart Club will not tolerate:

- Violence of any kind
- ➤ Harmful, threatening or actual acts of violence
- Verbal abuse of any form
- Any activity which places the safety of drivers, officials or spectators at risk of personal injury

The Waterloo Regional Kart Club Executive will ensure that:

- > All members of the Waterloo Regional Kart Club receive a copy of the "Zero Tolerance Policy"
- Officials respond appropriately, without delay and in a consistent fashion when dealing with an incident
- There are serious consequences for any individual who is in violation with this policy, including, but not limited to:
 - Disqualification for a heat resulting in zero points for the heat
 - **Disqualification** for the **race day** resulting in a **DQ**, which cannot be dropped from seasons points, for the **race day**
 - Suspension from the next race day
 - Expulsion from the Waterloo Regional Kart Club for the remainder of the season
- Repeat offenders will be dealt with more severely and violation with this policy may result in permanent expulsion from the Waterloo Regional Kart Club.

The purpose of this policy is to:

- Reduce the incidents of verbal and physical abuse
- Provide opportunities for officials to develop the skills necessary to handle incidents of verbal and physical abuse in a consistent manner
- Promote long-term prevention of verbal and physical abuse, and violence by preparing individuals to manage themselves in non-abusive way

Waterloo Regional Kart Club begins the 2020 racing season with this zero tolerance policy. As a member, official or individual associated with the Waterloo Regional Kart Club we expect you to do your part and set the example by complying with this policy.



2020 Drivers and Parents Pledge
