Rules and Regulations:

- COVID-19 Provincial Rules and Guidelines of will be adhered to including social distancing. Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate removal of all team members and no refund will be given.
- > Each team must practice social distancing and remain six feet apart from other teams
- Each team must be self-contained each member must have a face mask and hand sanitizer
- Cost of practice: \$50 per kart
- Each kart can have a maximum of 4 crew members (must arrive together)
- Anyone under the age of 18 must have a legal guardian present to ensure they follow social distancing rules
- Track will be closed and secured at 8pm daily
- 20 karts maximum on the property (first come first serve basis) once this maximum is reached gates will be locked. All teams remaining in the outside parking area must practice social distancing of at least six feet and remain with their own team
- > Trailers are to park on every third pad (2 pads between teams)
- > Maximum of 5 karts on the track at one time
- > Karts must enter the track from the in turn two of main track and exit off of turn four
- Each team is responsible for the removal of any garbage. No garbage cans will be provided and nothing is to be left behind. The pad is to be swept prior to leaving the premises.
- > Bathroom facilities will be open and concessions and garage will be closed
