

2021 MARKETING OPPORTUNTIES

The Waterloo Regional Kart Club is the largest non-profit Kart racing club in Canada and one of the largest in North America. Since moving to our new home at Flamboro Speedway in Flamborough Ontario in 2008 we have maintained a strong membership base and a consistent number of race day entries. Everything that is brought into the WRKC is given back to the members through track upgrades, prizes, trophies, picnic, year-end banquet, special awards, and more!

Oktoberfest is the largest single-day event in karting which occurs over Thanksgiving weekend, every driver goes home with a prize and extra special glass trophies and flags for the winners etc. Oktoberfest occurs at the clubs home track Flamboro Speedway.

The WRKC is currently doing a major renovation on the track to allow for more racing configurations for 2021. In 2021 they will run 14 races from May-October. We averaged 70 racers this season. With hopes to get that number in the 90's for 2021!

Our success has been largely based by creating a fun and competitive racing environment for our members, combined with providing the best value for competitive kart racing in Ontario. Keeping karting affordable for our members is our number 1 focus. Our club keeps our race day entries fees reasonable by running our race days almost entirely with volunteers, and through the generous support of our corporate sponsors. Providing value for our corporate sponsors has been one of the club's major goals.

Kart racing is considered the most affordable form of Motorsport, through this marketing proposal we hope to convince potential new sponsors that the WRKC is best value in Motorsport marketing.

Waterloo Regional Kart Club Fast Facts

- 2021 will be the clubs 40th year of racing
- We have racing members male and female who compete against eachother from 7 to 70 years of age
- A typical race day brings approximately 300-400 people to the race track and Oktoberfest around 500 people
- The WRKC has a number of 3rd generation racers, normally runs in the family
- A Go-Kart goes up to 90km/hr
- One of the benefits of karting is to help children succeed in life ie. learn mechanics/working on kart, lifetime friendships, deeper bonds with their parents
- Past WRKC members have gone on to have success racing cars at racetracks all across Ontario, hence our club motto, "Where Champions are Born"
- We are the largest kart racing club in Canada and totally run by volunteers
- We have been racing at the Flamboro Speedway location since 2008

WRKC Demographics and Commercial Facts

- Club events are generally attended by 300-400 people
- Over 500 people are expected to attend our annual Oktoberfest race at our home track at Flamboro Speedway
- Most of our club members are hands on participants, they work on, and prepare their own go karts
- Our youngest racer's are 7 years old and we have club members that race will into their sixties

2021 CHANGES

This addition of racetrack surface and curbing allows for up to 16 different track configurations that the club will be implementing into their series next season.
